ABSTRACT

Speech and thought presentation represents how speech and thought are presented in popular and influential communications, such as podcasts. This study aims to identify, explain, and quantify the categories of speech and thought presentation present in Jake's conversation segment on Eric Nam's Daebak Show Podcast. The data in this study were analyzed using a descriptive qualitative method, utilizing Leech and Short's (2007) theory of speech and thought presentation. The data is derived from one video from the Dive Studio YouTube channel: Eric Nam's Daebak Show Podcast, Season 3, Episode 12, featuring Enhypen's Jay and Jake. The results showed that all speech and thought categories were found in the podcast conversation. In speech presentation, there were found Direct Speech (DS), Indirect Speech (IS), Free Direct Speech (FDS), Free Indirect Speech (FIS) and Narrative Report of Speech Act (NRSA). In the thought presentation, there were found Direct Thought (DT), Indirect Thought (IT), Free Direct Thought (FDT), Free Indirect Thought (FIT), and Narrative Report of Thought Act (NRTA). The most frequently used presentation by Jake in the conversation is DS, followed by DT.
