

Kontribusi Antara *Sense Of Belongings* dan *Work Engagement* Terapis Anak Berkebutuhan Khusus di Salah Satu Layanan Psikologi X

Intisari. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk melihat kontribusi yang dimiliki oleh *sense of belongings* terhadap *work engagement*. Secara lebih spesifik, penelitian ini berfokus pada kemampuan kontribusi *sense of belongings* terhadap tingkat *work engagement* terapis Layanan Psikologi X begitupun sebaliknya. Sampel penelitian menggunakan 9 orang terapis anak berkebutuhan khusus yang bekerja di salah satu Layanan Psikologi X. Pengumpulan data dari terapis melalui skala SOBI-P yang telah diadaptasi ke Bahasa Indonesia oleh peneliti serta skala *work engagement*. Metode yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah uji korelasional *Spearman's rho* serta uji koefisien determinasi (R^2). Dengan diperolehnya nilai *p-value* < 0,05 serta nilai (R) sebesar 0,714, maka dapat disimpulkan bahwa terdapat hubungan serta besar kontribusi antara *sense of belongings* dan *work engagement* terapis anak berkebutuhan khusus di salah satu Layanan Psikologi X adalah 50,97%.

Contributions Between Sense Of Belongings and Work Engagement of Special Needs Child Therapists in One of the Psychological Services X

Summary. This study seeks to examine the impact of a sense of belonging on work engagement. This study especially examines how the experience of belonging impacts the level of professional engagement among therapists in Psychological Service X, and vice versa. The study sample consisted of nine therapists specialising in children with exceptional needs employed at one of the X Psychological Services. The therapists' data was collected using the SOBI-P scale, which has been modified for use in Indonesia by researchers, as well as the work engagement measure. The techniques employed in this investigation include the Spearman's rho correlation test and the coefficient of determination (R^2) test. Based on the *p-value* < 0.05 and the value of 0.714 for R, it can be inferred that there is a significant association between the sense of belonging and work engagement of therapists working with children with special needs in X Psychological Services. Furthermore, the contribution of sense of belonging to work engagement is determined to be 50.97%.
